Wonderful new Hands-On Learning resources continue to arrive. This May we have received additional Int. Science tools such as scales, test tubes and funnels (\$583.00) and Primary Language Arts resources (eg. CD stories and books on tape, plays and flashcards) as well as primary math & strategy games (\$1,130.00). We have now received a total of \$7,418.00 worth of new Hands-On Learning resources!

We have also received some new library books (\$712.00), purchased some skipping ropes for the Grade 1s (\$59.00), paid for the Gr. 1 Bike Safety talks (\$45.00) and the primary butterfly kits (\$221.00). Music supplies (e.g. mallets & spoons) were also received (\$420.00).

There was a great turn out at this past week's last CPAC meeting of the year! Mme Suzanne Simpson presented us with a teacher's update on a few things going on in the classrooms right now. She also told us about some of the inspiring things that her class has been doing throughout the year like volunteering at The Harvest Project.
