Old Growth and River Trail Walk

Friday, July 24th from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Take a leisurely walk through an old growth forest and stream ecosystem located along the beautiful Seymour River floodplain. You will be driven to and from this limited access site where you and your children will be immersed in a natural wonderland. Learn about plants, animals and other wonders of the watersheds with the help of a watershed educator. Bring a lunch and your camera, and wear sturdy shoes. Advance registration is required; call 604-451-6506. The cost is \$20 per family or \$7.50/adult; \$4/child/youth/senior.

Walking Tours of the Lower Seymour Conservation Reserve

Sundays, July 5th, 19th August 9th, 23rd from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Enjoy a walk through a coastal forest once used by First Nations and pioneers of our province. Learn about the forest environment, historical resource use, current water management activities and the future needs of a growing population. Short stops will give insightful looks into wildlife habitat, pioneering activities, logging history, water utility projects, and recreational opportunities. Approximately two kilometres of walking and a short shuttle ride to view water infrastructure. This walk is free and all ages are welcome. No pets.
