### ELIGIBILITY

This Contest is open to all staff and students in the North Vancouver School District. All entrants must include a fully-completed entry form and verify that any identifiable individuals in the photograph have their permission for photo release on file with the school/School District.

### MAY I ENTER MORE THAN ONCE?

Sorry, no. Just the once per person.

### HOW DO I SUBMIT A PHOTO?

First of all, you must be the photographer of the picture you are entering.

**If you're submitting a print photograph:** make sure your name, phone number/email are clearly marked on the back of the photograph, and that you have included a completed the entry form. Entries received by mail after the contest closes cannot be considered.

**If you're submitting an electronic photograph:** Make sure the photograph is a JPG file and attach a scan of your completed, signed entry form.

### THEN WHAT HAPPENS?

There are **three ways** to win. Winners may win in one category only.

## "Great Shot!" Contest Rules & Regulations

**CONTEST PERIOD:** The "Great Shot!" Contest (the "Contest") commences at 12:00:01 a.m. Pacific Time on Monday, January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and ends at 4:59:59 p.m. Pacific Time on Friday, February 4<sup>th</sup> 2011 (the "Contest Period"). Entries must be received before the close of the contest period. The Contest is being sponsored and administered by the North Vancouver School District (NVSD/the "Sponsor").

**ELIGIBILITY:** This Contest is open to all staff and students in the North Vancouver School District. The entrant must be the photographer of the work. Objectionable content in a photograph will render it ineligible. As the jury, staff members of the NVSD Communications Committee are not eligible to participate in the contest. Immediate family members of the Committee are eligible to enter, but the Committee member must acknowledge the relation and is not permitted to judge in the category the relation has entered.

**PRIZES:** All prizes are to be accepted as awarded and are non-redeemable. The prize list is as follows:

**Elementary student category**

Kodak Easy Share Camera (two to be won, approx. value \$150 each)

**Secondary student category**

Flip Ultra HD Video Camera  
(two to be won, approx. value \$215 each)

**Staff category**

KOBO e-reader (two to be won, approx value \$149 each)

**Participaton draw**

One random **participation prize**, drawn from all eligible entries not awarded a Voter's Choice or Jury Prize (\$100 Kidsbooks gift certificate)

The "Voter's Choice" prizes are awarded based on the greatest number of votes received by voters for an individual photograph. Ten finalists in each category will be eligible for a "Voter's Choice" prize, as chosen by members of the jury and must meet all entry criteria. Photographs that do not meet all entry criteria will be deemed ineligible for shortlisting and all other prizes.

The jury prizes will consider all eligible entries and are awarded at the sole discretion of the contest jury. The jury's decisions are final.



**VOTING AND JUDGING:** Evaluation for shortlisting for the Voter's Choice finalists and the special Jury Prizes will be based: on the following criteria:

1. Creativity/originality/overall appeal 50%
2. Photographic quality 50%

In the event of ties, the photo with the highest "Creativity" score will be deemed the winner/eligible for the shortlist. If those scores match (Creativity/Creativity), the highest in the "Quality" score of the two will be deemed the winner/eligible for the shortlist. If ties still remain, the tied entries will be rejudged based on the same criteria as outlined above.

The first round of judging will take place in the week following the closure of entries to select the shortlisted entries. Final judging and Jury Prizes will take place the week following the closure of the online vote.

All finalists' photographs will be available for review at [nvsd44.bc.ca](http://nvsd44.bc.ca) between February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011. All visitors to the site may vote, once in each category, for the photo of their choice.
