September has sped by us. The month has been busy with children settling into classes and routines. This month, we talked about the Virtue of Acceptance. Lynn Valley students accepted the challenge to raise \$1000 for Terry Fox. Our grade seven students lead this challenge, under the leadership of Miss Hudson, with daily reminders and a wonderfully prepared student lead assembly on September 27<sup>th</sup>. The assembly taught our students about the life and challenges of Terry Fox and the many values he espoused and upheld. Grade 7s also lead the Terry Fox Run on September 28<sup>th</sup>. We would like to thank all of the Lynn Valley School families who donated generously towards our goal. A total of \$1248.76 was raised! All funds will be donated to the Terry Fox Foundation.

We would like to remind parents that there is no supervision of students after 3 pm. Please ensure that you have made arrangements for your child when they are dismissed. We have had a number of complaints from parents that there are students climbing on top of the containers on the east side of the school by the field. Please remind your children that this is extremely dangerous and they are not to be on top of the containers.

The phones in the office are for emergency use only. With over 300 students we do not allow students to use the phone to make after-school play dates. Arrangements for play dates need to be made the day ahead from home with parents' approval.
