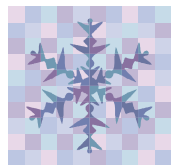

Additional tickets may be available if space permits and will be assigned on December 11th. Requests will be numbered and limited to 2 seats.

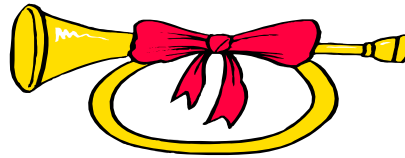
Please bring your tickets with you to the concert. Doors will open at 6:15 pm. Those with tickets will be seated first.
