### INFORMATION ABOUT SEPTEMBER 2011:

### SCHOOL SUPPLIES

For all students entering primary grades (Grade 1 to Grade 3) at Ridgeway Elementary in September 2011, we are offering a service to facilitate the purchase of student school supplies. The school will purchase all items needed by primary students in bulk and pool the supplies. This will enable the teachers to purchase the exact materials needed for the classroom. The cost will be \$42 and the money will be collected in September.

For all students entering the intermediate grades (Grades 4 to 7) supply lists were included with the students' report cards. Students can purchase their supplies over the summer months and bring them labeled and ready to use on the second day of school in September.
