 - Three copies of an essay of up to 600 words by you describing your community leadership involvement that is the basis of the application
 - Three letters of support of confirmation from the community group, groups or individuals who have been the focus of your involvement
 - A letter of recommendation from your school
 - A transcript of your academic record
