

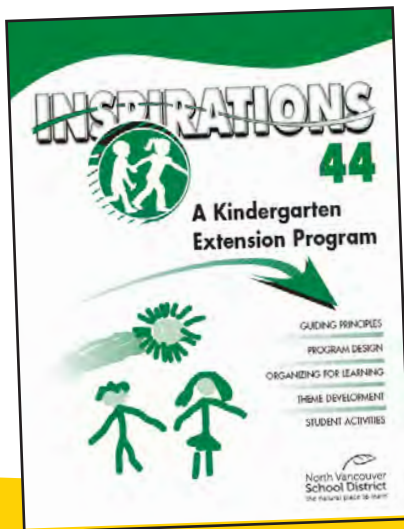
# Inspirations 44
